

Refund Policy

Pacific Rim Early Childhood Institute Inc. is designated by the Private Training Institutions Branch and complies with the refund policy of this designating body.

- 1. Registration fees are non-refundable.
- 2. Refunds required under this policy will be paid to student aid (if a student is student aid funded), the student, or with the student's permission, to the person who paid the tuition or fees on behalf of the student, within 30 days after receiving notice of withdrawal or refusal of study permit; providing a notice of dismissal; or the date on which the first 30% of the hours of instruction are provided (no-show).
- 3. If a student enrolled in a program without having met the admission requirements for the program and the student did not misrepresent the student's knowledge or skills when applying for admission, and the registrar advises the institution to refund tuition and course fees, 100% of tuition and course fees may be refunded.
- 4. If Pacific Rim Early Childhood Institute Inc. receives tuition from the student, or a person on behalf of the student, the institution will refund the student, or with the student's permission, the person who paid on behalf of the student, full or partial tuition that was paid in relation to a course or program in which the student is enrolled under the following circumstances:

Completed means the student has received an evaluation of their performance for the specified percentage of hours of instruction. If a student completed a portion of a program for which they did not receive an evaluation, that portion should not be included in the calculation of the percentage of the program completed.

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
